



Frequently Asked Questions

Where is it?

Holkham 10K is based at Holkham Hall in Norfolk. Please follow the postcode NR23 1AB which will bring you onto the estate by The Victoria Inn.

How old do I have to be to take part?

Participants entering Holkham 10k must be at least 15 years old as at the date of the Event.

What time is the event likely to start?

The start time for this event is TBC, but we estimate around 11:00 which is slightly earlier than previous years.

When will the Final Race Information be emailed out?

We release the Final Race Information one week before the event date. Final Race Information will be available on the event website.

Where do we park and how much is it?

Parking is accessed via the main North entrance. Please follow the signage and stewards on the day. There may be a charge for weekend parking. This is likely to be around £3, this will be confirmed in the Final Race Information.

When/Where do I register?

You will register from Saturday 6 July in the main registration tent, which will be on the area in front of the house, by the cricket pitch. There will be signposts and site plans.

What do I need to bring?

Simple clothes and trainers that you feel comfortable running in and some safety pins for your race number. If you do not have any safety pins these will be available in the registration tent, but we do ask for a donation to charity.

Will there be somewhere to leave my bag?

There will be bag storage available. Please make sure you write your race number clearly on the label you will be given in the tent and make sure you have your race number when collecting your bag.

I have a medical condition; do I need to let you know?

Yes, please. We cannot treat you appropriately if we do not know that you have a condition. Please give us information when you enter. We also ask that you write MC on the front of your race number and the full details on the back, so we can treat you as quickly and appropriately as possible.

Can I look at the course before the event?

Yes. The course will be signed by Friday afternoon. It will be signed using orange arrows.

Are there awards for the winners?

Everyone completing the race will get a bespoke medal.

There will be awards given for categories, more information will be available in the Final Race Information.

How do I withdraw?

If you need to withdraw, you must do it in writing to info@osbevents.com before 21 June 2019. Before this time, you will be given a 50% race credit. After this date we cannot issue any form of credit. Your withdrawal will be taken from the date that the email was received, even if it is not actioned for a couple of days. No refunds will be payable in the event of a withdrawal.

Please do not give your place to anyone else as we do not allow transfers for this event. It nullifies the insurance and places them at risk if we do not have their details and they are involved in an accident.
