

CLUMBER 10K – RACE INFORMATION

Race numbers

At the registration marquee, please join the correct lane for your race number. Numbers are allocated prior to the event and will be available at www.onestepbeyond.org.uk.

Please make a note of your race number before arriving at the event.

Race numbers will be available at morning registration but will increase your registration time. Numbers must be worn on the front of your running top, and **must not** be folded or altered in any way as this will lead to disqualification. **Please bring your own pins.**

Electronic Timing

To ensure accurate race times and competition results, every runner will receive a numbered timing chip to use whilst racing. As competitors pass through the finish line, results and category positions will be updated live. The timing chip must be worn on your training shoe, please do not attach the timing chip to your waist or wrist as it **will not** work.

Please remember to return your Timing Chip to the registration marquee.

Water Stations

There will be two water stations provided; one will be situated at Hardwick Village, the halfway point, and another at the finish line.

First Aid

First Aid will be provided by The Red Cross.

Medals

After finishing the race, please hand in your Timing Chip at the registration marquee and receive a special medal to celebrate your participation in the event.

At the finish

Please make sure that your Race Number is clearly visible for race officials. As soon as you cross the finish line, please proceed to the drinks station and then to the registration marquee. In order to keep the finish area clear for other runners, please meet your supporters beyond the registration marquee, where you will be able to view live results.

Prizes

Prizes will be presented at the Registration Marquee at 11.00hrs, or 10 minutes after the last competitor has finished.

Entries will be split into categories according to age and gender. Within these categories, there will be prizes for first, second and third place, with an overall winner's prize and team prize.

Results

Live results will be available at the registration area and all results will be published at www.onestepbeyond.org.uk in the week following the race.
