EVENTS

Lincoln Half Marathon – Sunday 1 October 2017

This document outlines details of the road closures and diversions that will be in place on the day of the event.

Key Notes:

- The event will be delivered by OSB Events, with support from Lincoln City Council and Lincolnshire County Council.
- If this document does not include the information you require, please email info@osbevents.com
- There will be around 3,000 runners taking part in the event, with approximately 4,000 spectators expected. As a result, the roads are likely to be busier than normal on the day of the event. If you have any planned journeys, please allow additional time.
- The majority of pavements on the course will be open as normal. The only area on the course where there will be restricted access on footpaths; Brayford Wharf North, where participants will follow a barriered section of the course.

Car Parks:

- Access to Lucy Tower car park will only be possible from the West via Brayford Way onto Newland, which will be controlled by temporary traffic lights as the road will be partially closed.
- Orchard Street will be closed, therefore, access to Orchard Street/City Hall car park will not be possible.
- All other city car parks will be unaffected.

Access and Egress from North Carlton

Between the hours of 07:30 – 13:00 the B1398 will be closed to traffic heading towards Lincoln; however, residents can exit left towards the A1500 (Till Bridge Lane) and return via the same route. Access and egress from Broxholme is unaffected.

Access and Egress from South Carlton

Between the hours of 09:00 and 10:30 there will be no access or egress allowed as the B1398 will be completely closed from Gate 6 of the Showground. Between 10:30 – 13:00 the B1398 will be closed to traffic heading towards Lincoln; however, residents will be able to exit South Carlton by turning left onto the B1398 towards the A1500 (Till Bridge Lane). Return will be possible after 11:30 via Burton Village, turning left onto B1398.

Access and Egress from Burton Village and Burton Waters

Between the hours of 07:30 and 09:00 there will be managed egress from the village towards the A1500. Between the hours of 09:00 – 10:30 the B1398 from Gate 6 of the Showground and Fen Lane through the village will be totally closed. After 10:30 the B1398 will be closed to traffic heading towards Lincoln, however residents will be able to exit by turning left towards the A1500 (Till Bridge Lane). However, from 10:30, when Fen Lane reopens after the last runner, residents will be able to access the A57 by turning right towards Saxilby.

The A57 from Burton Waters roundabout to the Pyewipe turning will be completely closed from 09:00 to 11:30. Residents of Burton Waters will be able to turn left towards Saxilby. There will be a diversion in place but we would suggest that the quickest route into Lincoln will be via Skellingthorpe.

Access and Egress to Burton Road (inside the A46 Flyover)

Between the hours of 07:30 to 13:00 Burton Road will be partially closed, although there will be managed access onto Burton Road as outlined below: -

City Bound side – Vehicles will be able to turn left onto Burton Road towards Lincoln and follow Yarborough Crescent to Newport Roundabout; where they can either exit the City via Riseholme Road, or follow the diversion into the City Centre. Residents off Queen Elizabeth Road will be able to exit and return via Riseholme Road.

Dunkirk Road – Vehicles can exit during the managed times above, and return via Queen Elizabeth Road, turning left onto Burton Road then left back into Dunkirk Road.

Outbound side – From 07:30 northbound vehicles will be diverted down Queen Elizabeth Road. Vehicles will be able to exit towards Yarborough Crescent. After 09:45 there will only be managed egress towards Yarborough Crescent. Return to properties on the outbound side of Burton Road will only be possible via Queen Elizabeth Road, turning left onto Burton Road and crossing the course managed by stewards, when it is safe to do so, until the last runners pass at around 12:15.

Yarborough Crescent/Newport Area

Yarborough Road will be closed from 09:00 to 12:30. Yarborough Crescent and Newport are open this year. There will be no access to the Yarborough roundabout so egress will be via Riseholme Road or Longdales Road.

Lincoln Castle, Bailgate, Westgate and Burton Road (to the roundabout)

Lincoln Castle will be open to the public but there will be a barriered channel for the runners. Bailgate will have managed access prior to 09:45 but be closed from Castle Hill to Westgate between the hours of 09:45 until approximately 12:00.

Westgate will be closed, as will Burton Road.

Union Road and Carline Road

Union Road and Carline Road will have managed egress until 09:45 and then will be completely closed until approximately 12:00. After 09:45 there will be no exit onto Yarborough Road until it reopens at 12:00.

Yarborough Road, West Parade and The West End

Yarborough Road will be closed between 09:00 and 12:30, and there will be no access from any adjoining roads. West Parade will be closed between Beaumont Fee and Yarborough Road from 09:00 until 12:30. Other exit roads from West Parade onto Carholme Road are unaffected.

The Avenue will be closed Northbound at its junction with Yarborough Road from 08:00 to 12:30; however, residents on Victoria Terrace and adjoining streets can cross Yarborough Road under Marshalls supervision, and exit South onto the Avenue from 08:00 until 09:45.

Access to the City via Brayford Way is unaffected, although we would recommend allowing additional time.

Newland will be closed from its intersection with Wigford Way and Beaumont Fee to Orchard Street from 09:00 until 12:00, but access will be available for Lucy Tower car park with traffic lights controlling access and egress.

Diversions

Full diversion signage will be in place around the City, please ensure you follow the signage.
